



JAMES began in the middle of 2009, three years after CMMAP began (1 July 2006).

Who named JAMES?





The first official publisher of JAMES was Institute of Global Environment and Society (IGES)




AGU became the official publisher in 2012. AGU began partnership with Wiley-Blackwell in January 2014 (JAMES format changed from 2- to 1- column).

JAMES became AGU's first open-access journal

AGU now has 3 open-access publications

- JAMES (2009): Robert Pincus CU/NOAA ESRL PSD
- Earth's Future (2013): Ben van der Pluijm University of Michigan
- Earth and Space Science (2014): John Orcutt –
 Scripps

Total publications by year




Journal Impact Factor

JAMES 2014 impact factor = A/B = 4.92 where:

A = the number of times that JAMES papers published in 2012 and 2013 were cited by indexed publications during 2014

B = the total number of papers published by JAMES in 2012 and 2013
